## WHAT IS DETAIL COVERAGE?

Detail Coverage is the portion of your wedding day that I capture the special elements you've chosen for your wedding ensemble. These are heirloom photos that you'll cherish long after those items become damaged, no longer fit, or get ruined or lost with time.

Every Rachel Elle Photography couple has the option to include a free extra hour of detail coverage in advance of their wedding date.

## WHAT I NEED:

Rings - all three!

Stationary - multiple copies of the whole set

Envelopes - addressed or plain is fine
Any other paper goods (if applicable)

Jewelry

Shoes -his and hers

Groom's accessories - ties and cufflinks

Florals

## THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

Plan a full hour for me to capture your details.

For brides having their details captured the same day as their wedding, consider having the bouquets and boutonnières delivered to the getting ready location. Ask your florist for loose blooms and greenery for details shots!

Bring extras! Bring multiple copies of your stationery, as well as addressed and undressed envelopes so I have options for composing the photographs.

I always provide backdrop, velvet ring boxes, and ribbon. If you have a specific look in mind, feel free to bring extra items like an antique jewelry box or other unique items that I can incorporate into the design.

Have everything set aside in its own box in the getting ready area so that it's ready when I arrive.
